Dear Neighbor:


At the January 18th Board of Supervisors meeting, many members of the community expressed concerns with the current zoning in the southern quadrant of Hellam Township. Given this interest, the Board of Supervisors has decided to open discussions with community stakeholders regarding a Conservation Zone within this area. As Chairman for the Board of Supervisors, I am welcoming one representative of the community to join the Hellam Township Planning Commission, Environmental Advisory Council, Supervisor Trimmer and myself in establishing a Conservation Zone Exploratory Ad-Hoc Committee. This committee will engage with the community and present recommendations to the Board of Supervisors regarding the vision and viability for such a zone. The committee will meet once a month to discuss changes in an informal workshop style where area residents can comment and provide feedback regarding changes to southern Hellam Township.
